



Appropriate Attire in The Tides Collocated Club

1. The following policies are required of all patrons dining, reserving, visiting or otherwise utilizing The Tides Collocated Club facilities:

- a. All patrons of the Patrick Air Force Base Tides Collocated Club are responsible for ensuring that their personal attire, and the attire of their family members and sponsored guests are in compliance and meet dress code requirements.
- b. A high standard of dress and personal appearance is required of all persons who enter The Tides Collocated Club facilities. This standard includes neatness, cleanliness and safety at all times.
- c. Wearing of the military uniform will be in compliance with AFI 36-2903; Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel, and with the appropriate directives which prescribe the wearing of the military uniform for other service members.
- d. Military headgear is not authorized for wear in The Tides Collocated Club at any time with the exception of armed Security Forces, Honor Guard, Fire Department and Military Public Health in the performance of their duties.
- e. Casual civilian attire is permitted throughout The Tides Collocated Club at anytime unless otherwise advertised.
- f. Casual sportswear is defined as dress shorts (mid-thigh to knee length, nicely hemmed), khaki and jean trousers, collared sports/polo shirts and blouses, tennis shoes, open-toe casual sandals/flip flops, sports clothing, tee-shirts (not undershirts) and other casual attire may be worn in all areas of the club provided it is in good taste and presentable.
- g. The following attire is not permitted in any portion of The Tides Collocated Club at any time:
 - Swim wear (i.e. bikinis, one-piece swim suits, board shorts, swim trunks, wet suits, cut-off jean shorts, etc.).
 - Muscle man shirts
 - White tank tops or "A" frame undershirts
 - Cut-off shorts/pants
 - Partial military uniforms (i.e. jackets, ADU shirts or trousers)
 - Exposure of any undergarments, sports bras, biker shorts, etc.
 - Dirty/soiled clothing of any type
 - Any attire that bears upon it any language including single letters, words, phrases or pictures that are profane, obscene, or could otherwise bring discredit to the integrity or professionalism of the United States military or the United States government will not be allowed.
 - Any attire that reveals nudity, etc.
- h. Patrons that enter the facility wearing such items will be refused service and required to exit the facility.
- i. Patrons that fail to wear appropriate shirts and shoes will be refused service and required to exit the facility.
- j. Patrons that are requested to exit the facility will also be required to exit the parking lot area, deck area and all adjoining parking lots and premises of The Tides Collocated Club.

2. The Tides Collocated Club management reserves the right to refuse service to any individual that does not adhere to these requirements.
