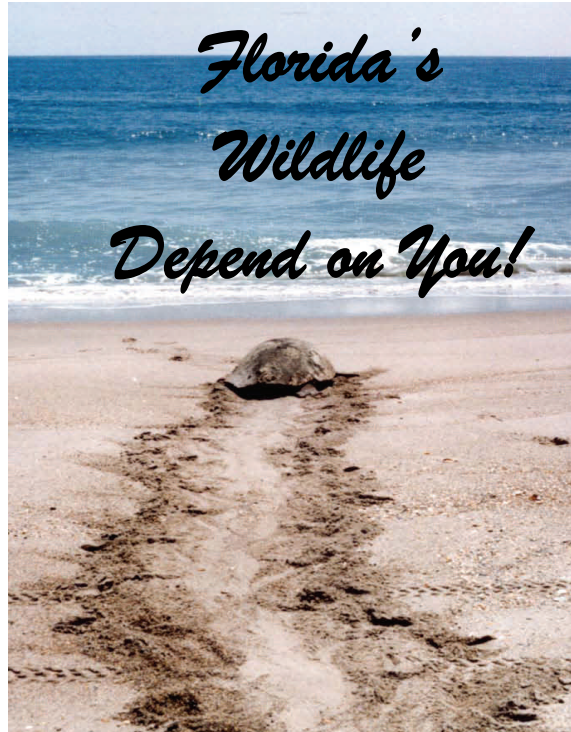




Welcome to Patrick Air Force Base & Florida's East Coast!

Please do not forget that you are on Federal property & must abide by all applicable laws. In addition to you, many unique plants & animals use the base.



All personnel, tenants, and visitors on PAFB must follow the requirements to protect sensitive species/habitat:

- Sea turtles nest each year from March through October on PAFB beaches; during peak season from May to October please minimize lighting unnecessary for safety/security (all necessary exterior lighting must be downward-directed, shielded and amber/yellow.) -Lighting glow even miles from the beach can disorient sea turtles.
- Avoid trampling dune vegetation at the beach or wetland vegetation along the riverfront. (mangroves are State protected).
- Do not allow pets to harass local wildlife.
- Abide by Florida's fishing laws.
- Dispose of your garbage or put recyclables in appropriate bins.
